About the Course

This course is aimed at learners wishing to build on the knowledge and skills covered at Level 2, further developing the underlying principles and practical skills required by the hairdressing industry. Level 3 is geared towards senior stylists and colour technicians involving more complex and advanced practical techniques, as well as taking responsibility for others with less experience.

As an apprentice, you will be working in a hairdressing salon. You will assist in the smooth running of the salon and support the stylists. You will generally spend 4 days a week at work and one day in college. A typical day in the workplace will involve welcoming the clients, performing varied hairdressing services and general housekeeping duties. You must be willing to learn new skills and take part in training activities to enhance your learning. The day you are in college you will do some theory based work and some practical tasks.

The majority of apprentices will continue in paid employment in a salon once they complete their qualification.

A hairdressing apprenticeship will suit you if you have an artistic flair. You must have good stamina as you are often on your feet all day. You will need good people skills and be able to communicate well with clients and your fellow staff members.

Hairdressing apprentices will be expected to buy a uniform for the college based practical sessions and a hairdressing kit consisting of essential equipment such as, scissors, brushes, clips, practice heads etc. The estimated cost for this will be £215.00
