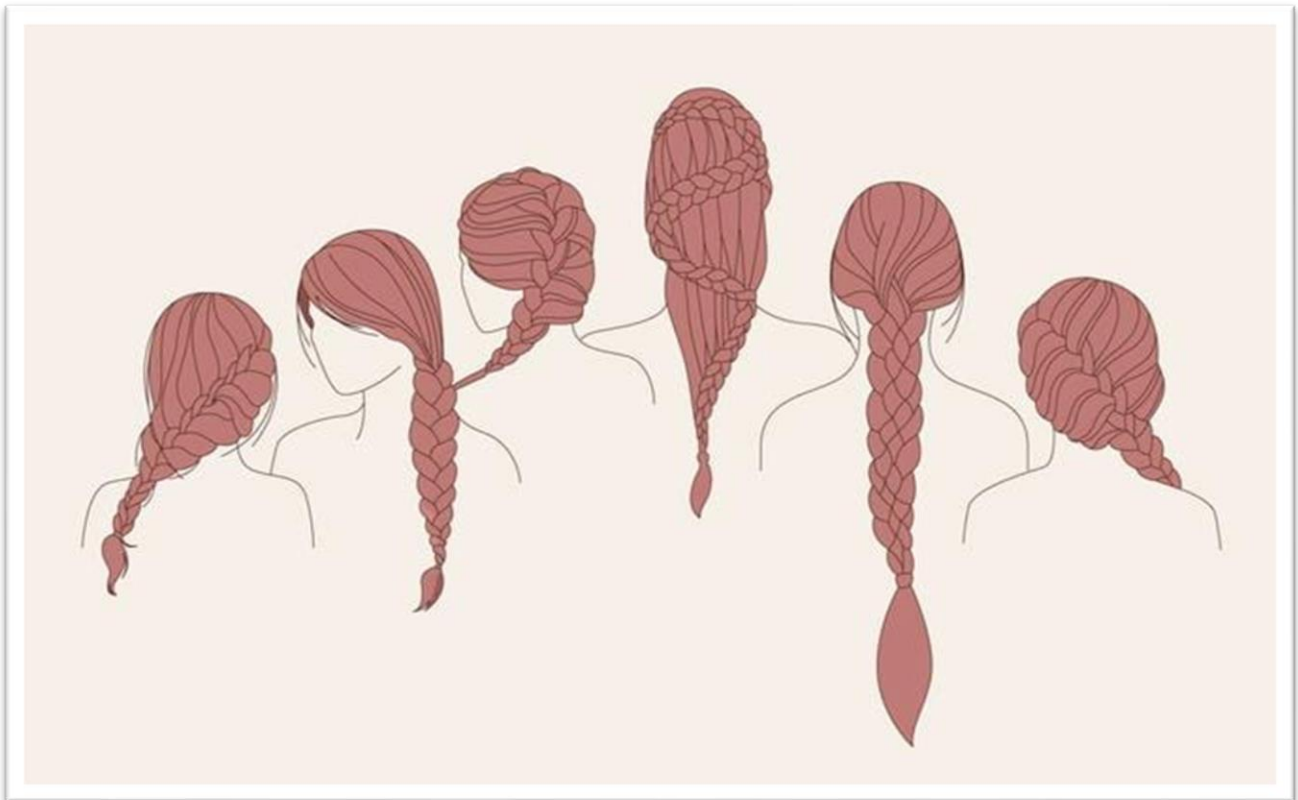


HAIRDRESSING - **TASTER DAY PACK**

Section 1 - PEN PROFILE

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Section 2 - RESEARCH TASK

Research and list as many different plaits as you can. In the chart can you grade yourself out of 10 on how confident you feel doing these?
