- White gloves

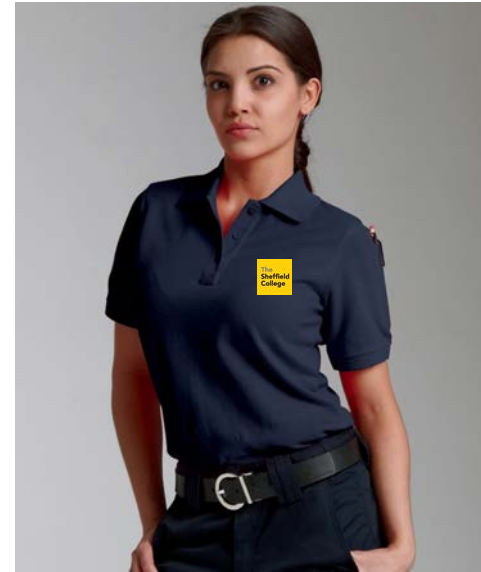
Kitchen Uniform Breakdown

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Our First Event of 2020



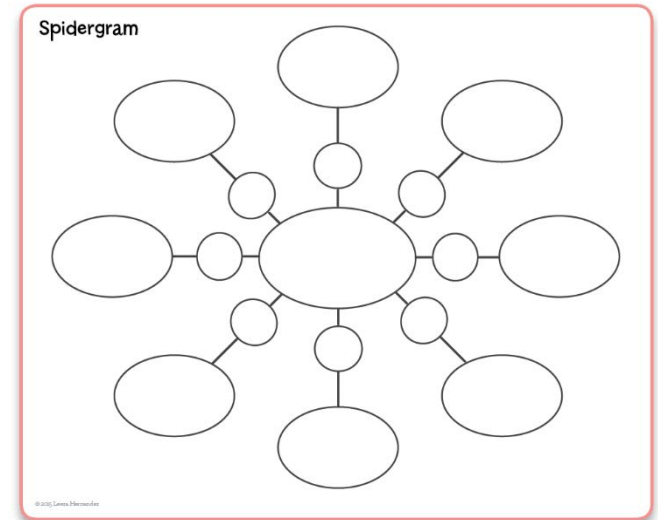
Hopefully our first event will be a Macmillan coffee morning held in the college restaurant on Friday 25th September 2020 !
