Internship Pathway: Supported Internship

Overview

The Internship Pathway: Supported Internship has been designed for individuals with an EHCP who need support to progress into employment after post-16 education.

This pathway is a structured, work-based study programme providing a substantial work placement, facilitated by a Job Coach and Work-Based Tutor, and is supported by a curriculum focused around employability. It will take 1 year to complete.

The intern will spend around 70% of their time in the workplace and will be supported to develop the skills valued by employers, demonstrate their skills in the workplace and develop their confidence for future job roles.

What will be studied

Conduct at work Job searching skills Understanding forms Developing independent travel skills Work rotations with different employers

How will individuals be assessed?

Individuals will be continually assessed against their EHCP targets through a range of methods including task-based, observations and booklet work.

Individuals will also be assessed using a range of methods in a work related environment.

Progress will be reviewed termly through formal meetings with the host employer and the college.

What can individuals do after?

Upon completion of this pathway, individuals can progress into sustained employment.

Alternatively, individuals may exit college and progress into employment and adulthood.
