- Texture

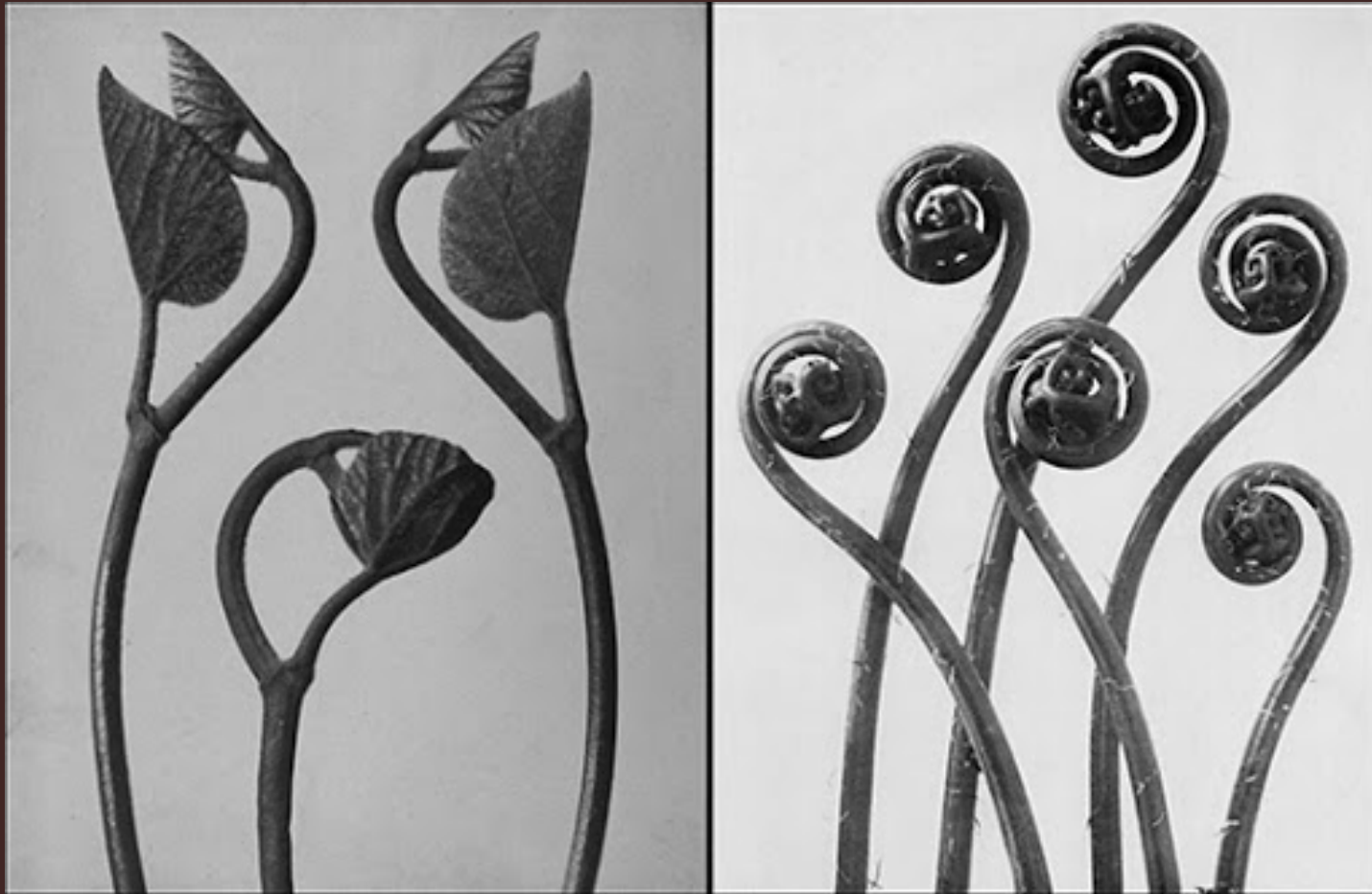
These images can be taken on a mobile phone if you do not have access to a camera

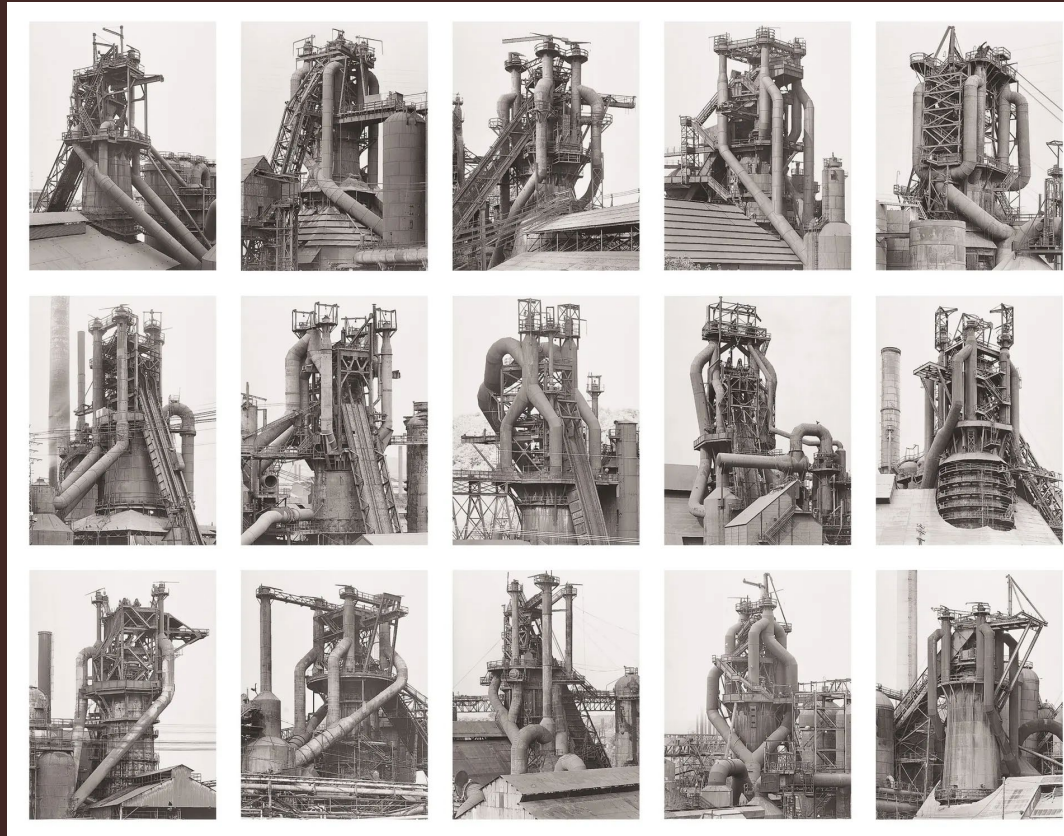
